
Project Goals

- 6. Incorporate station amenities to improve customer experience



Over 1,400 residential units and 90,000 sq. feet of retail space in development. For more information, see www.downtown berkeley.org.












DOWNTOWN BERKELEY EXISTING CONDITIONS



Access

- Opportunity to improve how space is used in station
- Crowding in center of station
- No platform access at south end of station
- Elevator is too small/awkward to access
- Escalator access only at center of station
- Bicycle access could be improved



- Lighting
- Poor visibility/lines of sight
- Remote or inactive areas sometimes feel unsafe



- Opportunity to improve comfort and function of station
- Public restrooms currently closed
- Opportunity for more retail on concourse level

Sustainability

- Improve efficiency (i.e., lighting)
- Resource conservation
