City of Alameda's Broadway/Tilden Way Intersection Improvements

SR2B award (total project cost): \$2.1 million (\$14.1 million)

Project location: Tilden Way/Clement Avenue between Broadway and the Fruitvale (Miller Sweeney) Bridge

Project components: This project improves walking and biking by constructing:

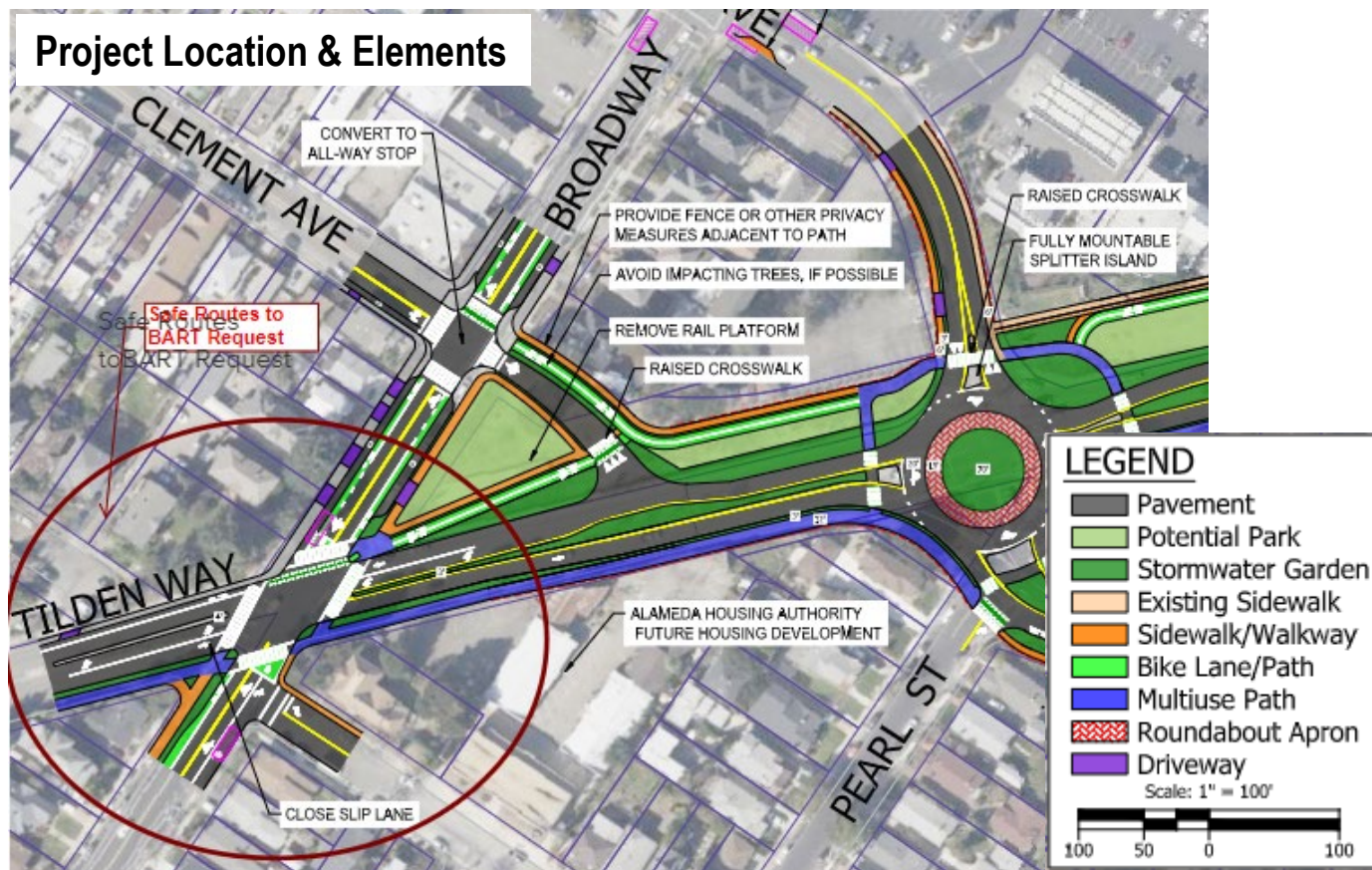
- Class 1 multi-use path and Class 2 bike lanes
- New and improved walkways
- Road diet on Tilden Way
- New roundabout at Tilden/Blanding/Fernside intersection
- Lighting and green infrastructure
- Parks and open space

SR2B funding: Extends the Clement Avenue/Tilden Way project's western limit on Tilden Way from Clement Avenue to Broadway. Intersection improvements include closure of eastbound channelized right turn lane, road diet, multiuse path, curb extensions, and modernized traffic signal equipment.

Distance from station: The Tilden Way/Broadway intersection is 0.9 miles from the Fruitvale BART station entrance.

Construction start (duration)*: Winter 2024/2025 (1 year)
