SR2B award (total project cost): \$3 million (\$5.1 million)

Project location: The Ohlone Greenway between the city of Albany border and Virginia Gardens

Project components: This project complements improvements that BART is currently installing on this Class 1 multi-use path and improves walking and biking by:

- Widening and repaving the path where feasible and making lighting and wayfinding upgrades
- Installing a new Class IV two-way cycle track connecting two closely spaced intersections
- Installing a variety of treatments, depending on need and context, at seven intersections:
 - Rectangular rapid flashing beacons
 - Median refuge islands
 - Raised and/or high visibility crosswalks
 - Sidewalk bulb-outs
 - Stop Controls

SR2B funding: Funds a portion of all elements of the project.

Distance from station: The closest intersection is 0.25 miles from the North Berkeley BART station entrance.

Construction start (duration)*: Summer 2025 (1 year)
