SR2B award (total project cost): \$3 million (\$8 million)


Project location: Fremont Boulevard between Walnut Avenue and Country Drive **Project components**: This project improves walking and biking by constructing:

- Grade separated bikeways on both sides of Fremont Boulevard
- Intersection improvements at Beacon Avenue and Capitol Avenue that include:
 - Curb extensions with directional ADA ramps and shared sidewalk landing area for pedestrians and bicyclists
 - o Traffic signal upgrades for enhancing bicycle and pedestrian access and interactions between all modes
 - High visibility crosswalks

SR2B funding: Funds a portion of all elements of the project and connects to the Walnut Avenue grade separated bikeway between Fremont Blvd and Paseo Padre Parkway (which received SR2B Cycle 2 funding).

Distance from station: The closest intersection is one mile from the Fremont BART station entrance.

Construction start (duration)*: Winter 2025/2026 (1.25 years)
