

Measure RR Safe Routes to BART Cycle 3 Project Fact Sheet

San Francisco MTA's Central Embarcadero Safety Project

SR2B award (total project cost): \$1 million (\$11.7 million)

Project location: The Embarcadero between Broadway and Brannan Street

Project components: This project improves walking and biking along the Embarcadero by:

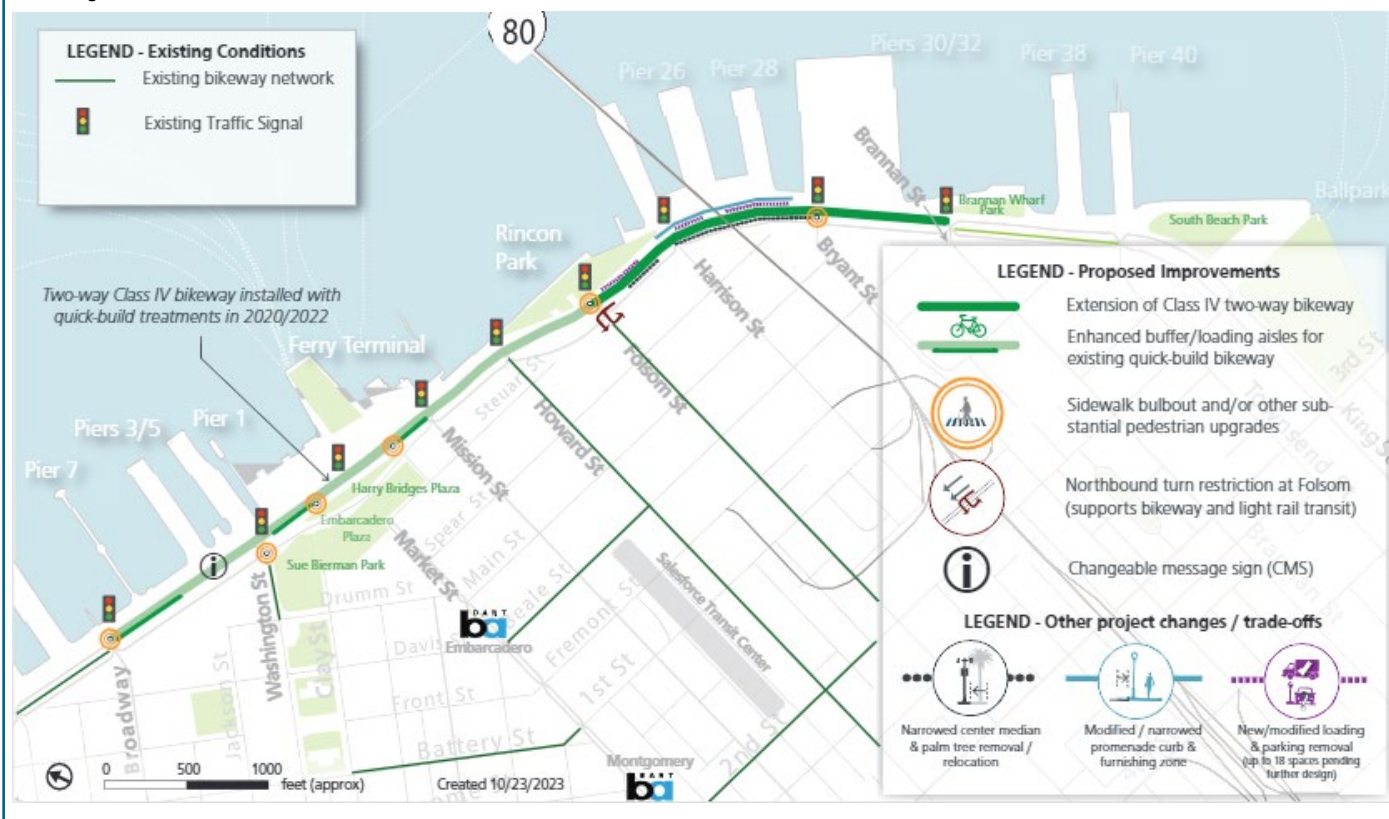
- Hardening and making permanent the two-way Class 4 cycle track and road diet that was originally installed as a quick build and extending it from Folsom Street to Brannan Street by modifying curbs and the median
- Installing more bike parking
- Implementing a variety of treatments, depending on need and context, at six intersections:
 - Turn restrictions
 - Sidewalk bulb-outs and safety islands
 - Curb ramp upgrades

SR2B funding: Extends the project from Bryant Street to Brannan Street.

Distance from station: Closest intersection is 800 feet from the Embarcadero BART station entrance.

Construction start (duration)*: Winter 2025/2026 (1.5 years)
